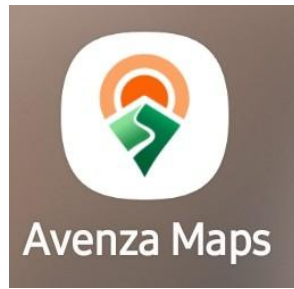


How to Work the Avanza Tracking App

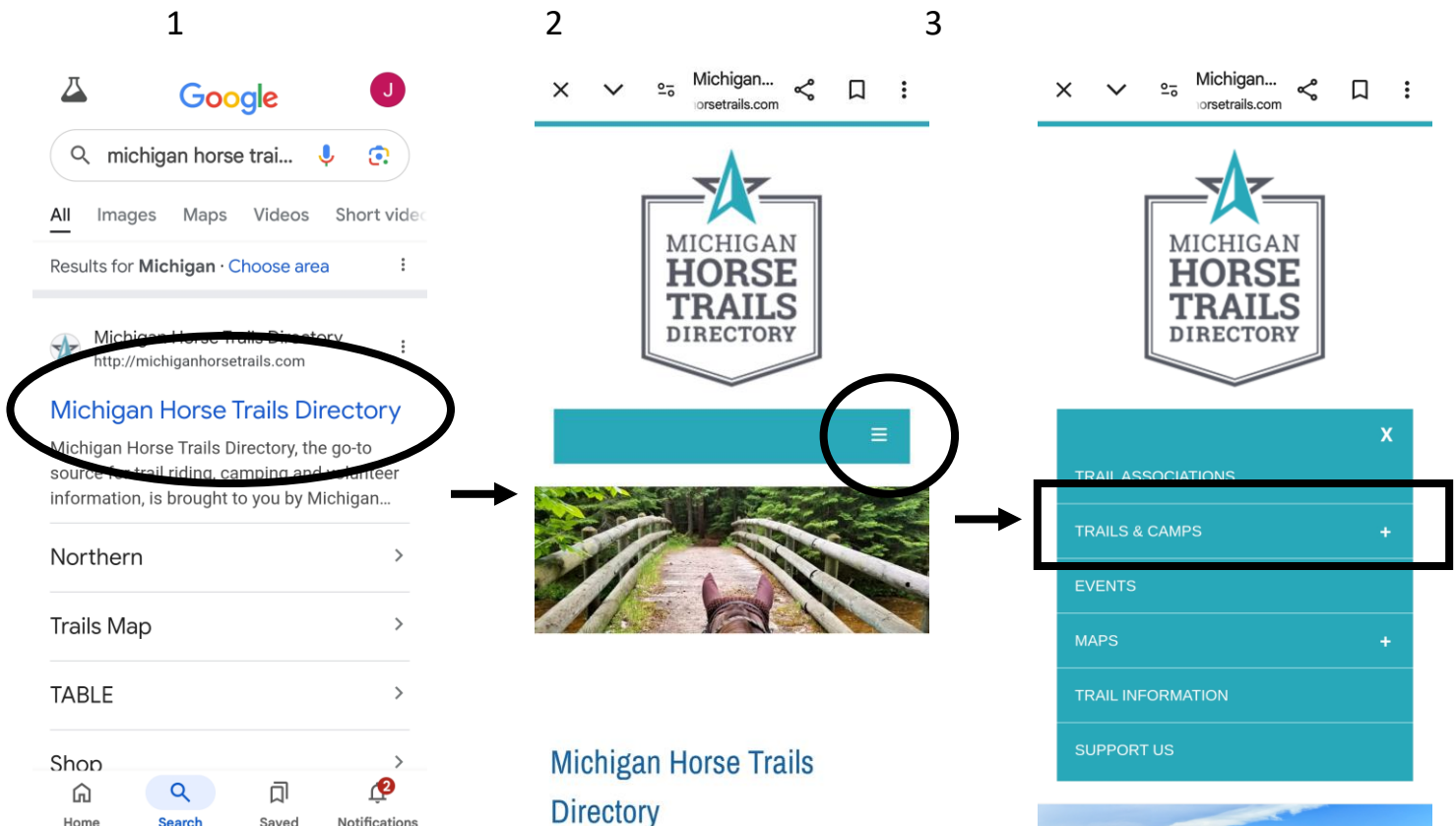


- Avenza is used by many Federal and State Agencies
- Using Avenza allows you to operate in Airplane mode (to save battery on your device) since it picks up Satellites to find your position.
- This Free App allows a Limited number of maps to be downloaded to the MY MAPS page. Many maps are free to download. Some agency maps have a minimal charge.

1. Download a Map

A. Using Michigan Horse Trails Directory

1. Search for Michigan Horse Trails Directory. Click on it.
2. Click on the 3 horizontal Bars
3. Click on "Trails & Camps"



4 Click Michigan area you would like the map from. Ie: Northern Michigan Trails is where Hungerford is found.

5. There are lists of Northern Michigan Trails. Scroll down to Hungerford Recreation Area

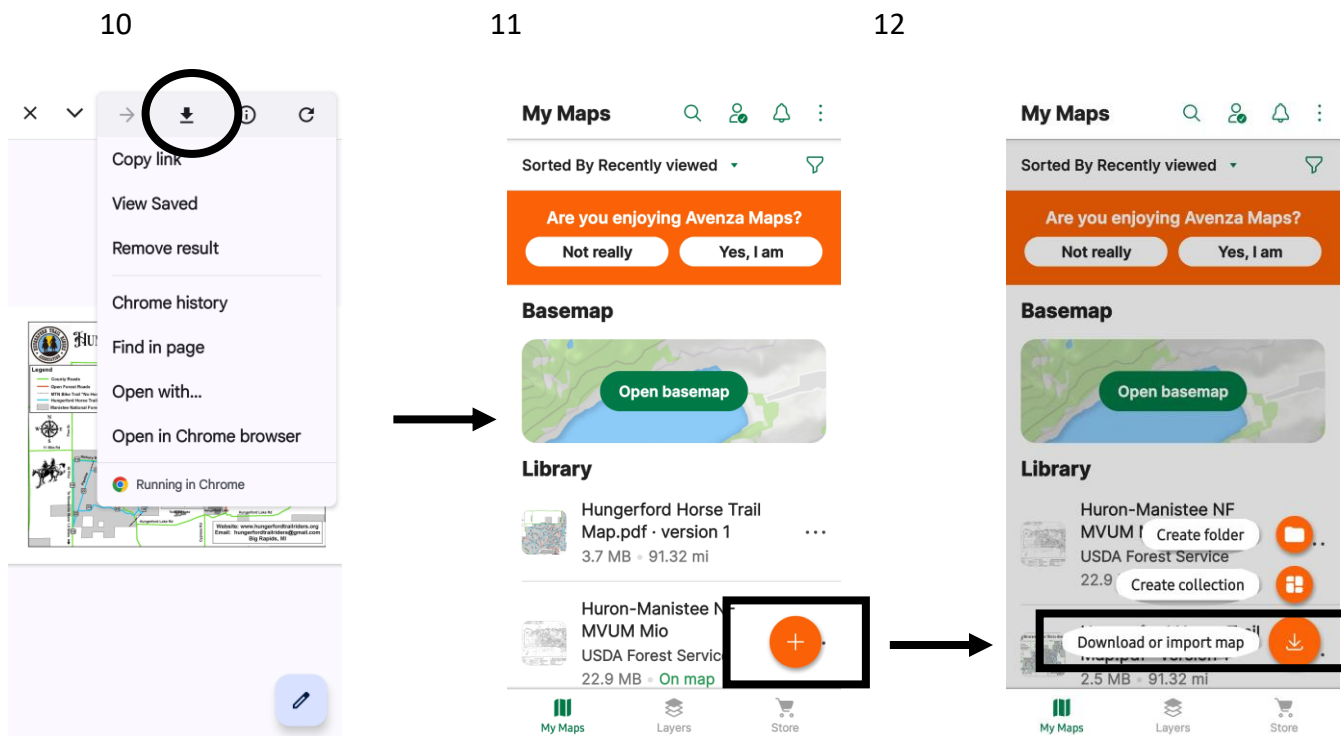
Map of Hungerford Trail System

11. Then close out of Michigan Horse Trails Directory and go to the Avenza App. Click on Plus (+) button

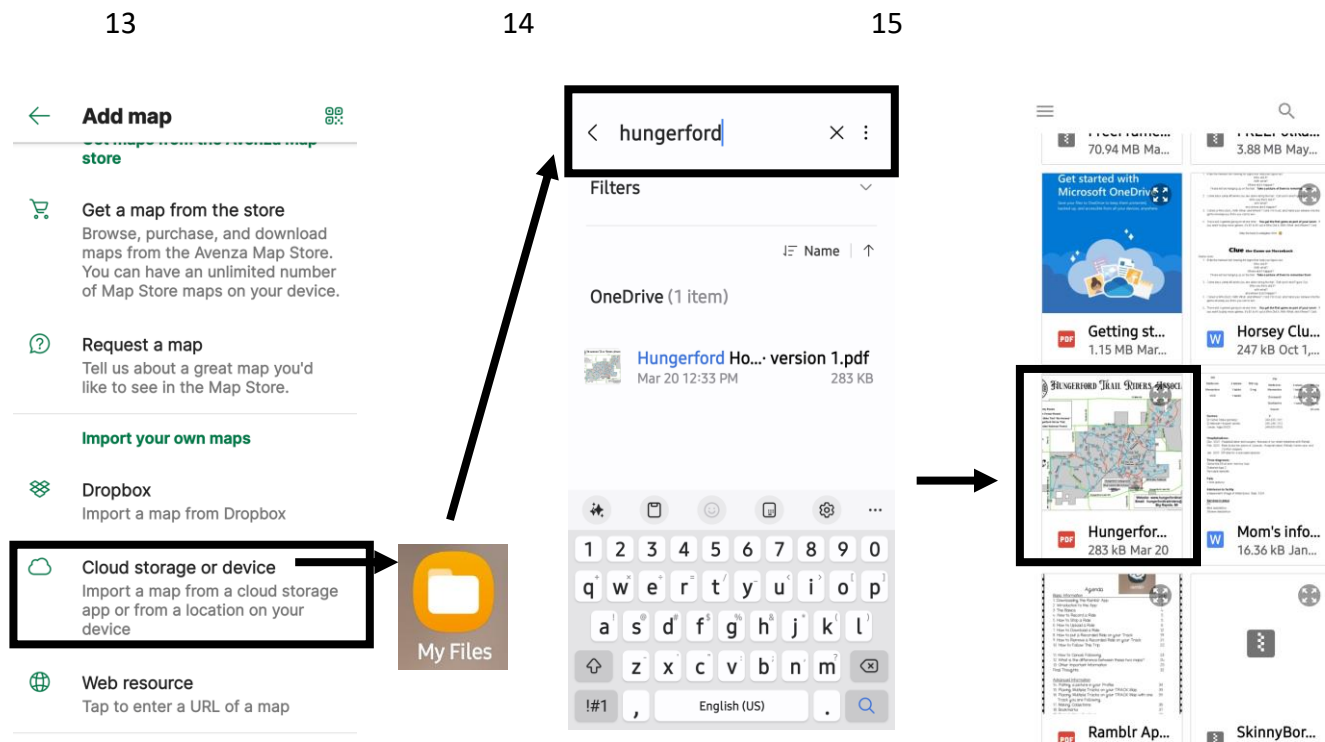
12. . Click on “Download or Import map”



13. On the Add map page, Click on Cloud storage or device. (Because you have downloaded map onto your device or phone)

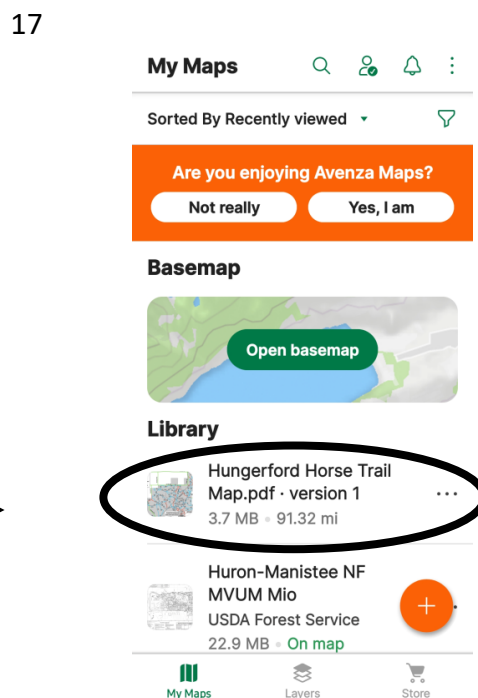
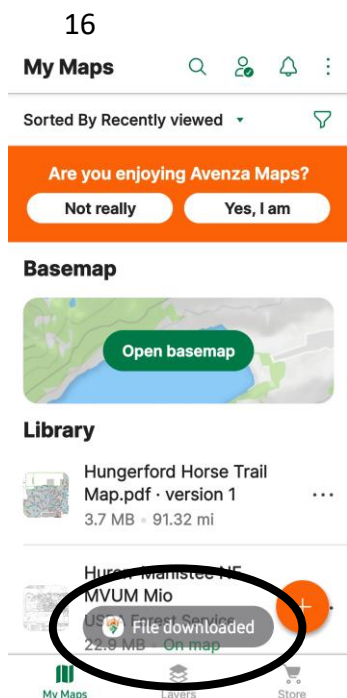
14. Find the pdf on your phone. You might need to find “My files” and search “Hungerford”

16. You should get a message that says “File Downloaded”.

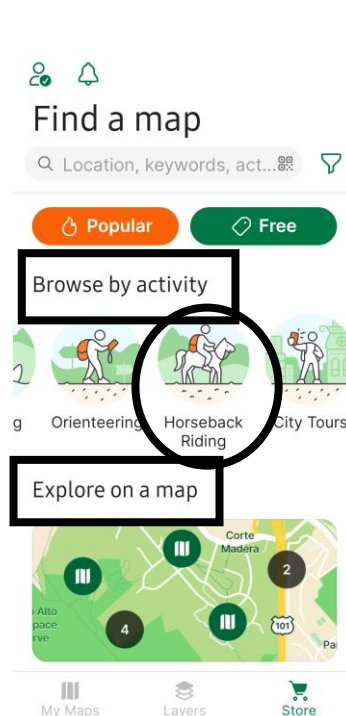
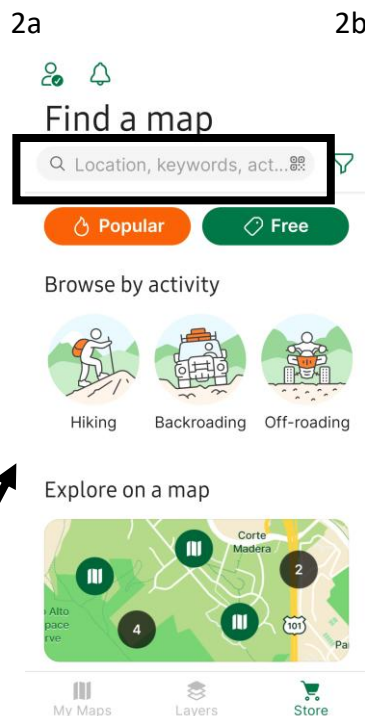
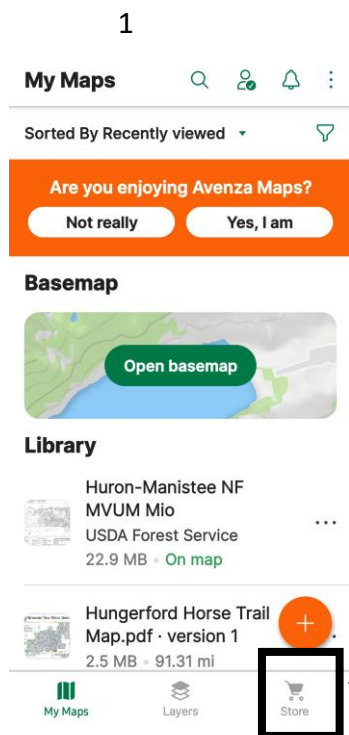
17. You should be able to see your map in your Library.



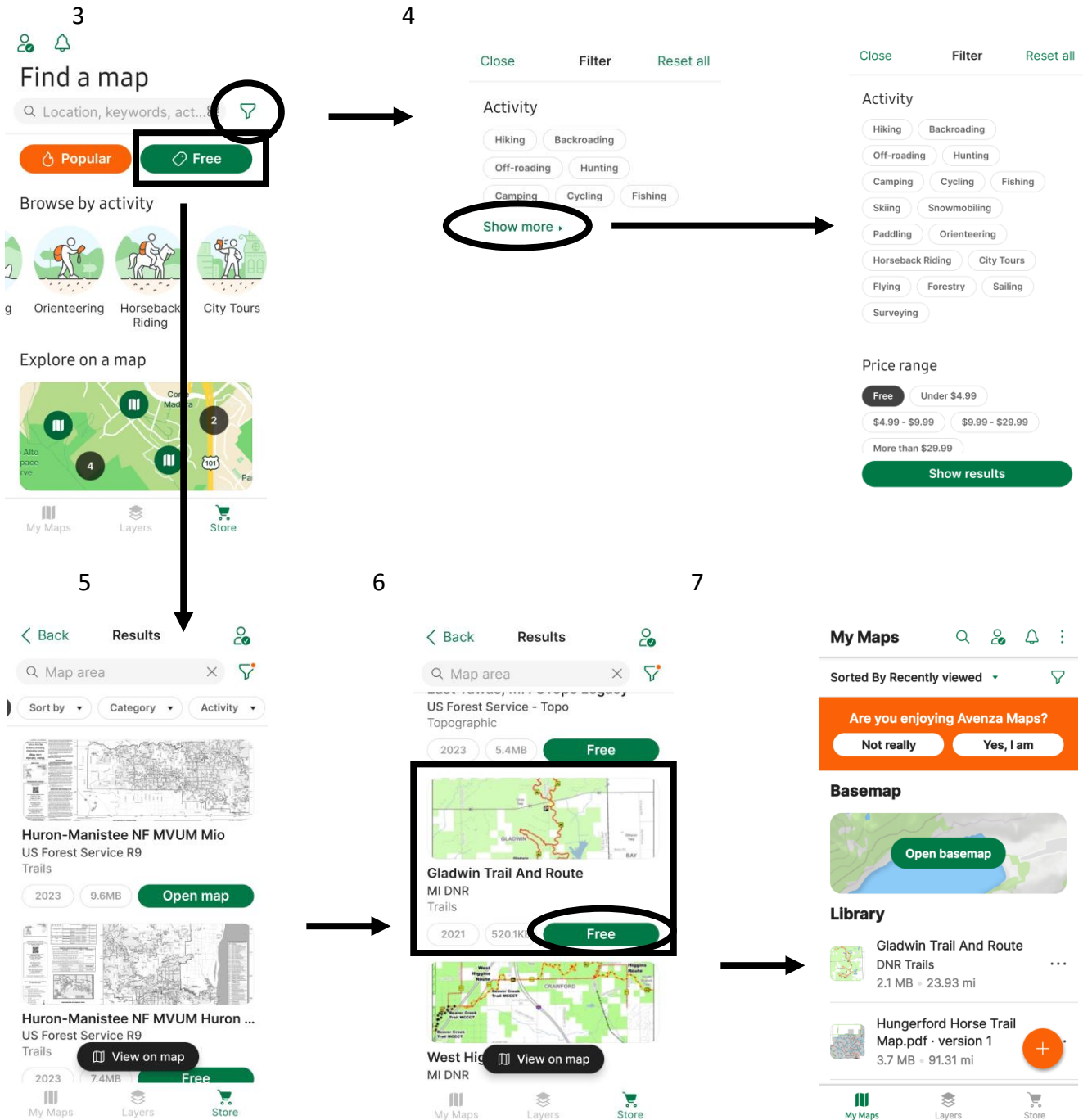

B. Using Avenza “Store” icon to find a Map

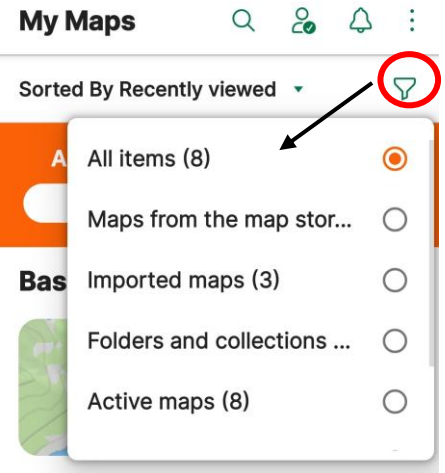
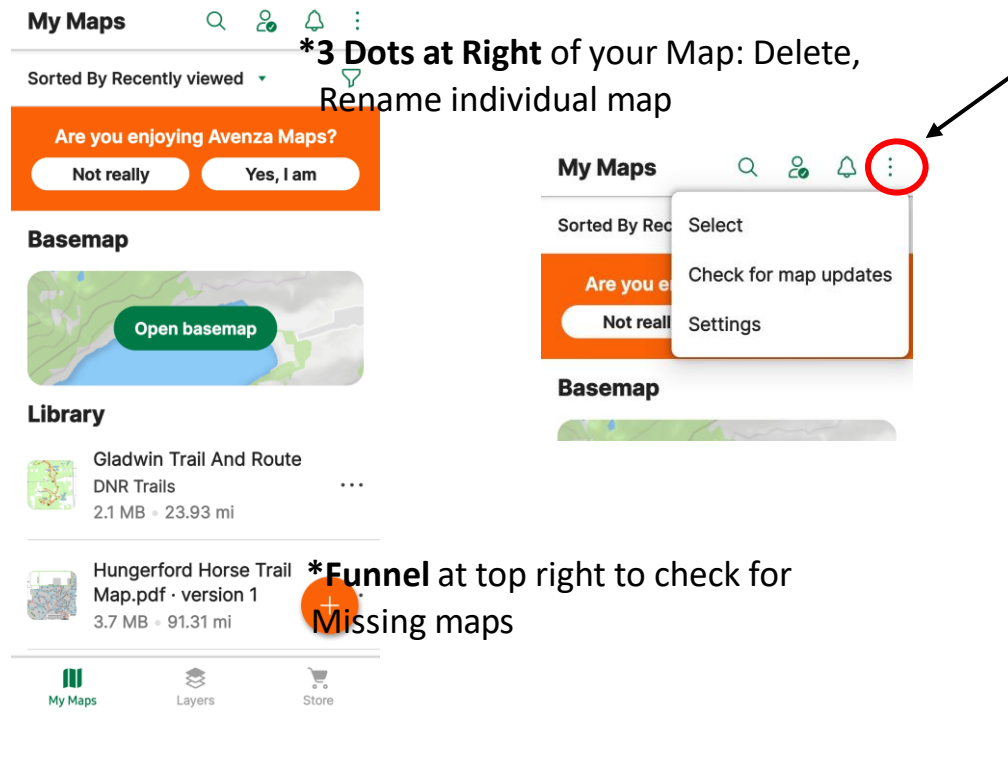
1. Click on the “Store” icon in the lower right corner.
2. You have options to help you find a map.
 - a. Use Location or Keywords tab to find maps
 - b. Browse by Activity
 - c. Explore on a map



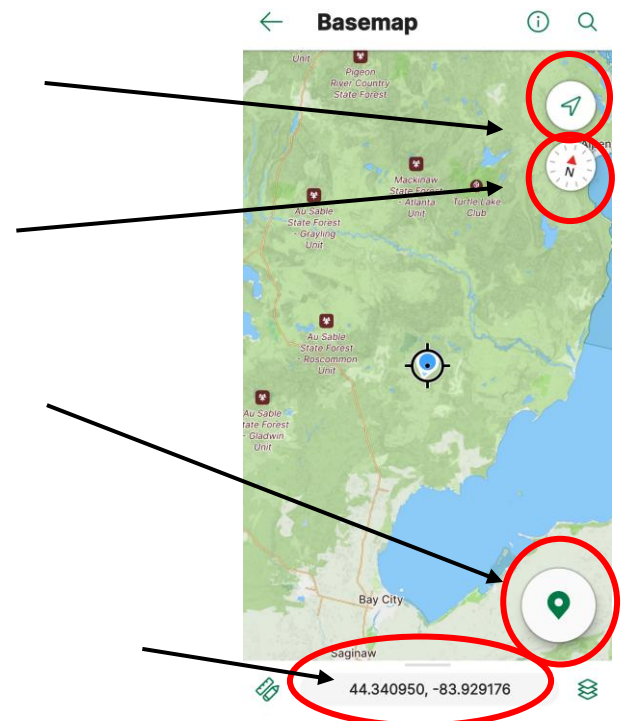
3. Click on **Funnel**
4. for more options: Category, Activity, Price Range, Product, Publisher
5. Or you can click on “Free”
6. Then scroll through to find a map. Click on “Free” to download.
7. You should see it in you Library

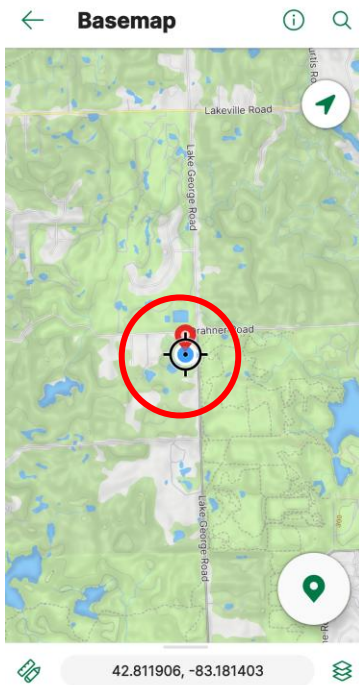


Use **Basemap** at top of MY MAPS page

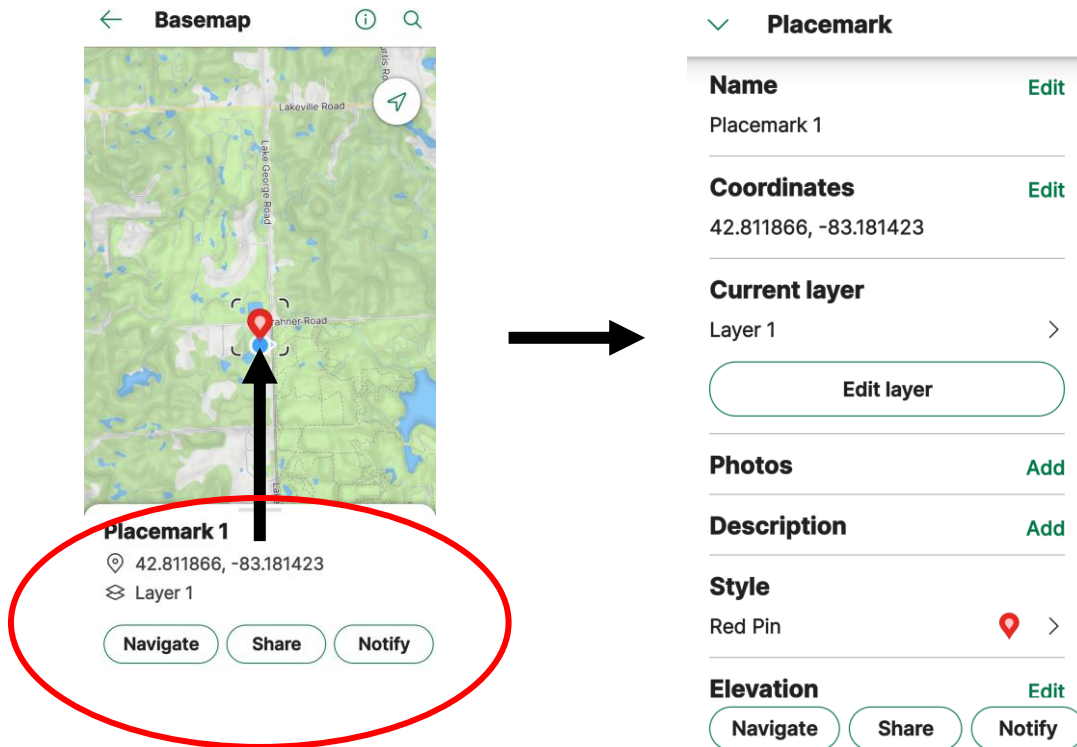


- 1.. As with all maps, With Location ON -**Blue Dot** follows you and shows the direction you're travelling.
2. **Arrow** at top right in map puts Target on your Location. and shows compass by tapping it.
3. **Compass "N"** top right: Straightens map to North up.
4. **Bubble** at lower right **Pins** location. Press on Bubble to label your placemark
5. *Be sure Blue dot and Target are together for proper GPS Coordinates*
6. **Coordinates** are at the bottom center of the map.
7. **Edit Placemark Pin:** Swipe up from lower box. Name, Location, Photo, Style, Navigate, Delete.

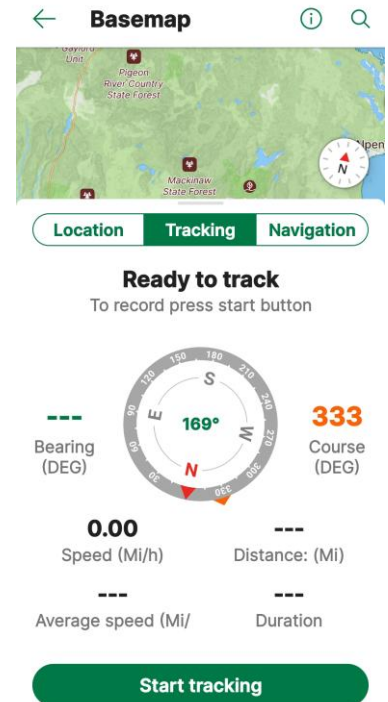
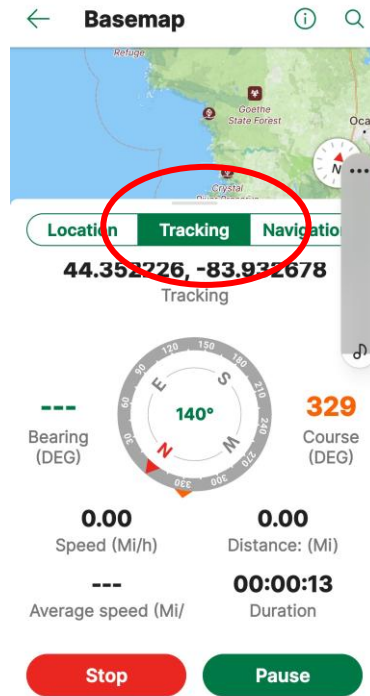
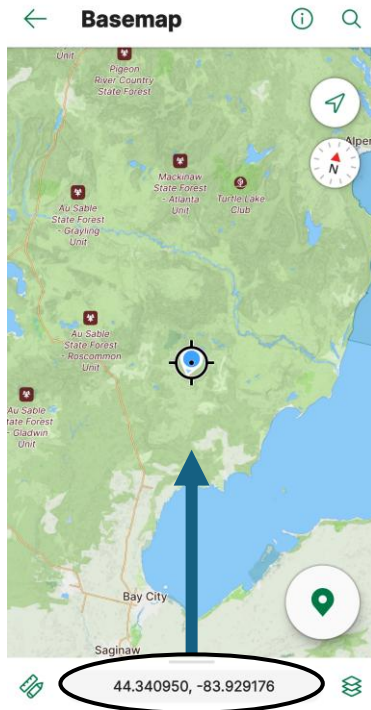




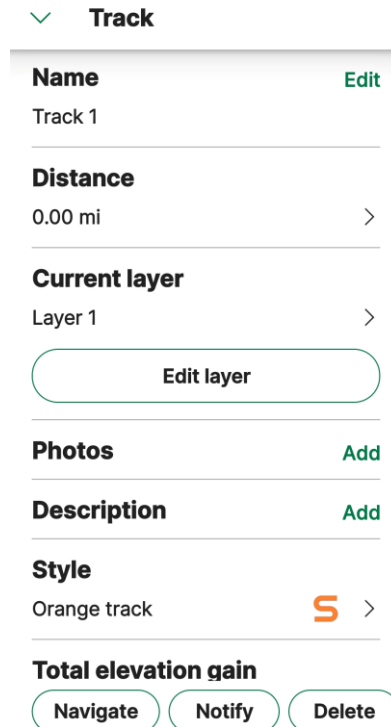
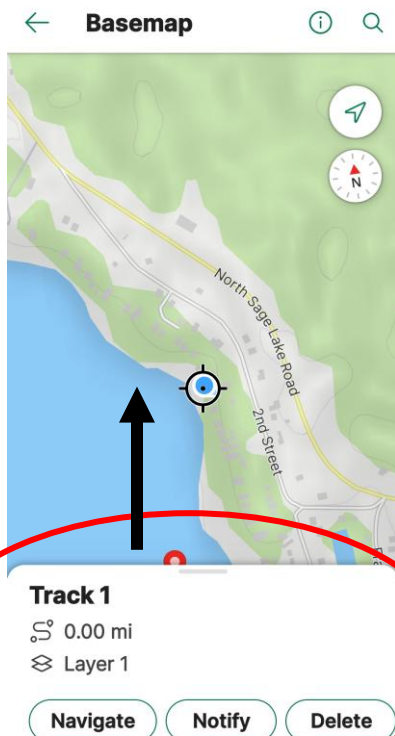
7. **To Edit Placemark Pin:** Click on Red Pin then swipe up **PLACKMARK 1** Name, Location, Photo, Style, Navigate, Delete.



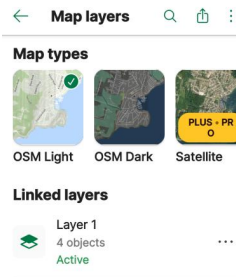
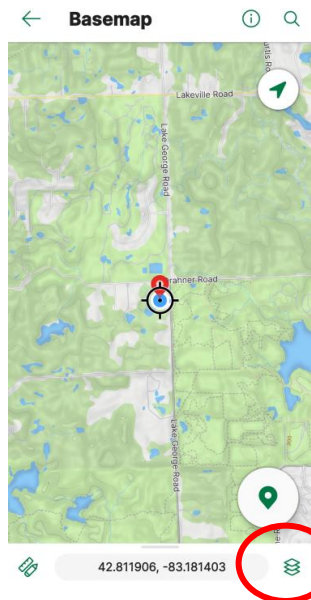
7.Tracking: Start/Stop/Pause. Swipe up from the Coordinates.



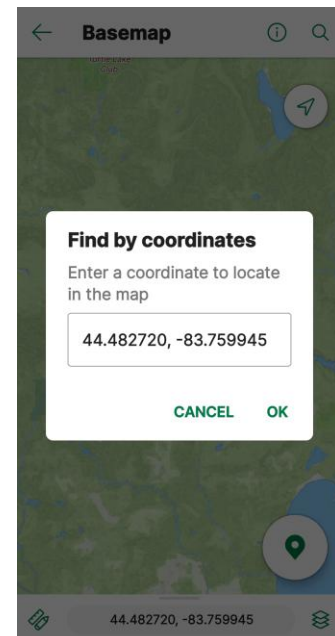
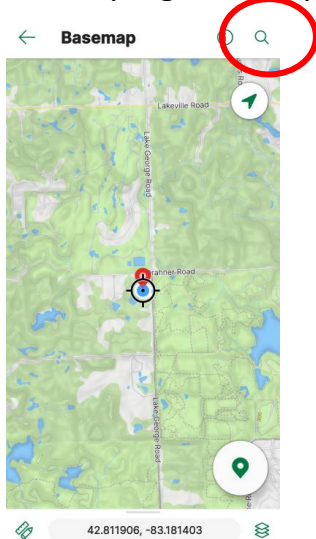
- **After Track is stopped**
- **Edit Track:** Swipe up from lower box. Name, Distance, Photo, Description, Style, Show Graph, Navigate, Delete.



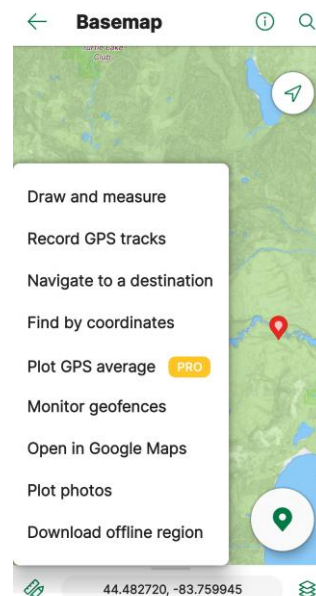
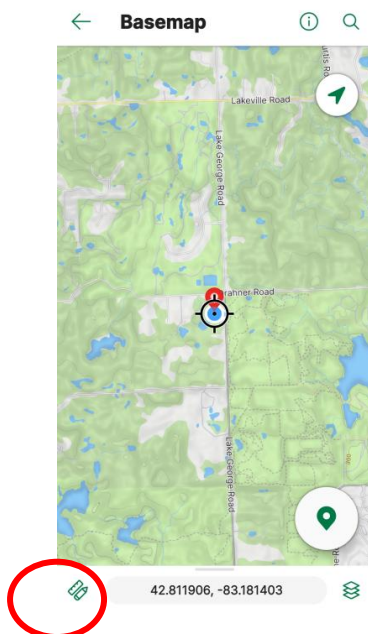
8. **Layers** folder (for all Tracks & Pins) is at lower right: Open layers. 3 Dots at right of description is the edit menu. Temporarily HIDE track or pin.

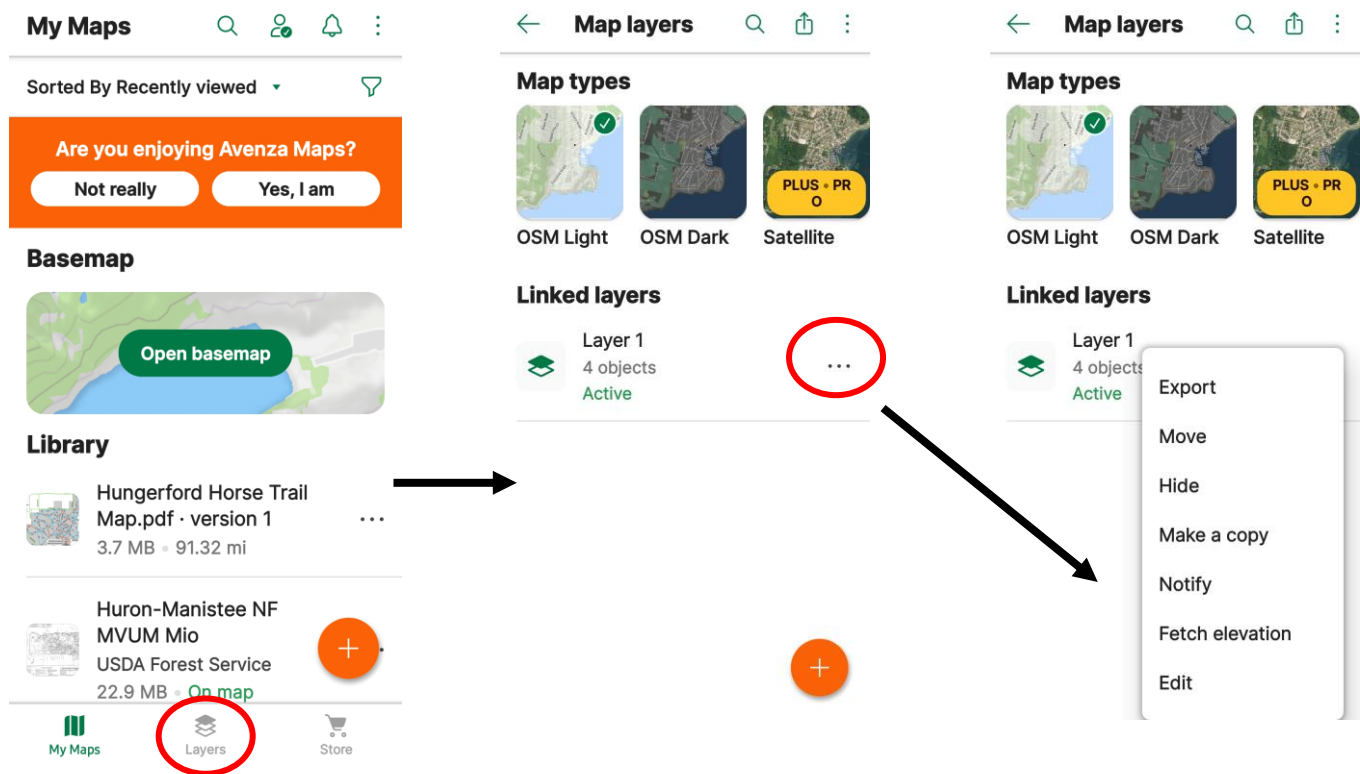


- **Search:** top right of map. Use coordinates.

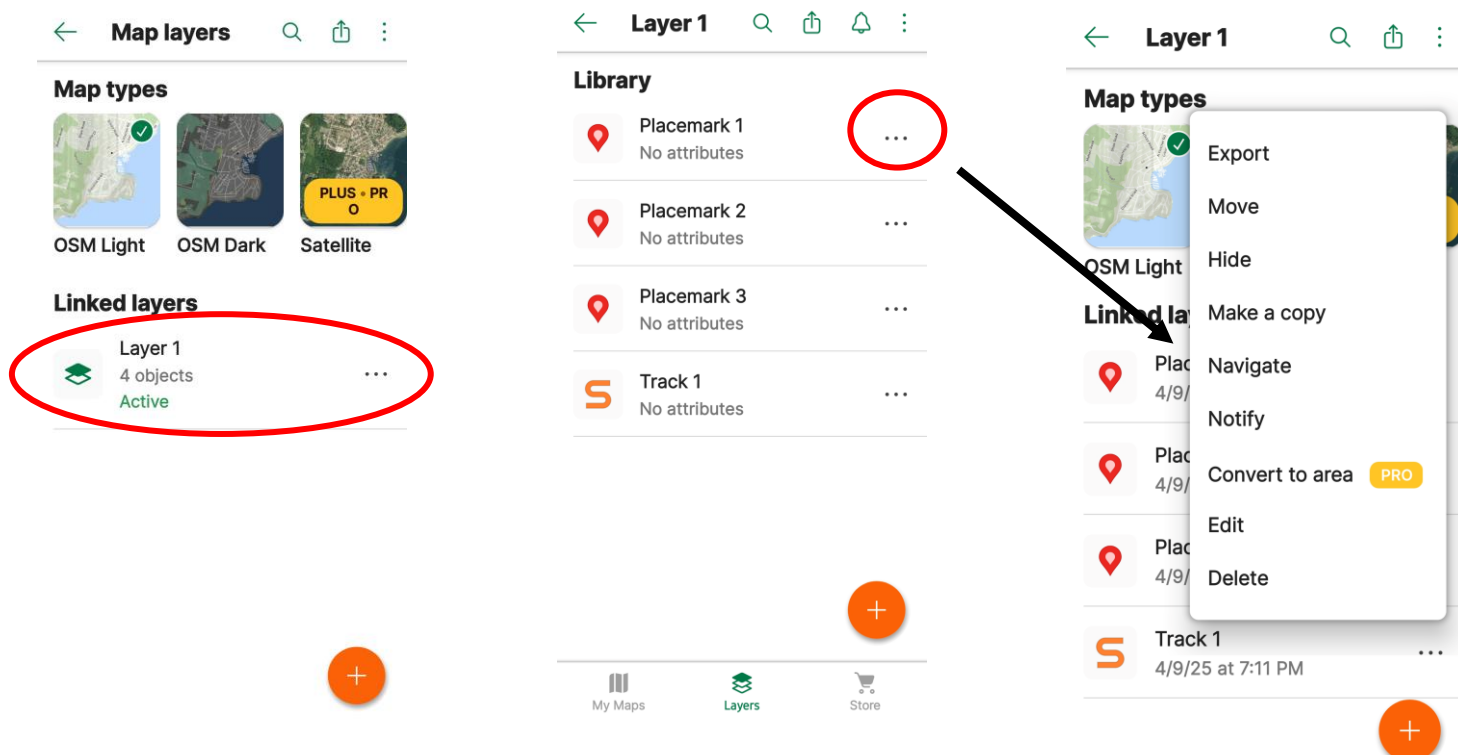


- **More Tools** at bottom left of map.





When you **click on your LAYERS** icon, it takes you to your Library filled with your maps. There are **3 DOTS on the right side** That can export, move, make a copy, edit, delete, etc..



When you **click on your LAYER** You can see all your maps and placemarks. Again there are **3 DOTS on the right side** that can export, move, make a copy, Delete, etc. that specific track or placemark
